

RSS at a Glance



In the year 1925, when the struggle for Bharat's independence was gaining momentum but the social fabric remained fragile, a quiet beginning was made in the city of Nagpur. Dr Keshav Baliram Hedgewar, a physician by training and a nationalist by conviction, brought together a small group of young individuals in a modest gathering. There were no banners, no formal declarations and no elaborate structures; instead there was conviction that a disorganised society could not hope to achieve enduring freedom. This was the genesis of Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh, or RSS, which in the course of next hundred years became one of the most significant movements in Bharat's (India) history.

Swayamsevaks are self-driven RSS volunteers whose disciplined life fuels acts of service at home, work and amongst communities.




Shakha




Milan and Mandli




Sthan
